Main report
Key Issues
A total of 49 applications were received for the Grant which were assessed by the Open
Spaces & Active Living (OS&AL) Unit and 35 applications met the criteria for an award to
be made, as shown in Appendix 1. The 14 unsuccessful applications are included in
Appendix 2.
An Independent Assessment Panel reviewed a sample (20%) of the applications, was
satisfied with the scoring and application of the criteria for the grants and approved the
recommendations for awards. The CGU will continue the administration of the grant
through notification to unsuccessful applicants, draft and distribution of the Letters of Offer,
holding workshops for grant awarded applicants, facilitation of payments and monitoring of
all awards, including financial verification visits.
Financial & Resource Implications
Tranche 1 - £89,251.64. The total budget for 2019/20 is £100,000. The scheme is
managed by staff from the OS&AL Unit and the Community Park Managers/Outreach
Officers are responsible for liaising with groups.
