To act as "place shapers" and local area advocates in order to identify and prioritise issues and opportunities to address local needs, with the aim of improving the quality of local people's lives. They will also consider how the City Centre integrates with neighbourhoods and communities, and vice versa, to ensure growth is optimised and inclusive across		
With this in mind, it is important that we work with Members to begin to develop this approach with a view to delivering on the following:		
 (i) Neighbourhood Regeneration Plans - We will focus on tailoring interventions within particular neighbourhoods where we believe there are opportunities to maximise synergies, identify and address gaps in provision and respond to opportunities (ii) Develop integrated services at a local level - In order to deliver neighbourhood regeneration we will develop a local area approach to the delivery of our services to
