| 3.2                      | A letter was forwarded subsequently to the Permanent Secretary, Department for  |
|                          | Infrastructure for the attention of the Minister in relation to the issue raised which is   |
|                          | attached at Appendix 1. The Minister's response is attached at Appendix 2.  |

| 3.3                      | The Minister by way of update explains that the Statutory Orders for the York Street  |
|                          | Interchange project including the Environmental Statement detailing the findings of the   |
|                          | Environmental Impact Assessment were published in January 2015. Following a Public  |
|                          | Inquiry in November of that year, the Designation Order for the scheme was made in  |
|                          | November 2016. The procurement process to award a contract for the detailed design  |
|                          | phase of this scheme was halted in early 2017 as a result of legal action. This legal   |
|                          | action concluded in September 2019, with the award of the contract being set aside. The   |
|                          | department are currently considering options for a new procurement strategy.  |
