3.2	<p><i>“Belfast bikes helps encourage citizens and visitors to our city to get around Belfast, while helping reduce our carbon footprint.</i></p> <p><i>Promoting cycling and investing in safe cycle lanes will be paramount in our fight against climate change.</i></p> <p><i>What if we can also help clean the air as we cycle.</i></p> <p><i>A new award winning design called Rolloe transforms the humble bike wheel into an air purifier that sucks in polluted air, filters out the pollutants and releases the clean air back out into the city.</i></p> <p><i>Similar to a motion last year to investigate the potential of city trees, I call on this Council to explore a pilot scheme to use Rolloe on Belfast bikes with the view to use throughout the fleet if successful and help promote all cyclists to explore the usage of Rolloe on their own bikes.”</i></p>
