Remember – you can recycle even more at any of our recycling centres:

- Alexandra Park Avenue, 180 Alexandra Park Avenue, BT15 3GJ
- Blackstaff Way, 1 Blackstaff Way, BT11 9DT
- Ormeau, 6 Park Road, BT7 2FX
- Palmerston Road, 2-4 Palmerston Road, BT4 1QA

You can collect extra food waste bags from any recycling centre.



£900

Black bin waste → goes to landfill

Every bin lorry filled with black bin waste costs us £900 to dispose of.



£520

Food waste bin → made into compost

Every bin lorry filled with food waste costs us £520 to compost.



£100

Recycling box waste → made into new items

Every bin lorry filled with recycling box materials costs us £100 to recycle.

# Your recycling box

Our new recycling and food waste collection services will help you recycle even more at home. Please use these services as much as you can to help us reach our recycling targets, save money and improve the local environment and economy.

Please put the following items in the recycling boxes in your shared recycling area.

 Plastic pots, tubs and trays	 Aerosols	 Cardboard	 Glass bottles and jars
 Plastic bottles	 Food and drinks cans	 Textiles (in a separate bag)	 Batteries (in a separate bag)
 Cartons	 Aluminium foil (in a separate bag)	 Hand tools	 Paper

 Please only put plastic bottles, tubs, pots, trays and cartons in the blue bin.

Please use boxes for other items. 

If you need extra or replacement boxes please ask your flat management company or call us on 0800 032 8100.

In some cases the flat management company may be the NI Housing Executive or Housing Association.

You can recycle all raw and cooked food waste in your Food waste caddy (except liquids).

 All dairy products	 Meat and fish (including bones)	 Raw and cooked fruit and vegetables	 Bread, cakes and pastries
 Rice, beans and pasta	 Teabags and coffee grounds	 Potato and vegetable peelings	 Any other leftover food

## How do I use my food caddy?

-  Line your caddy with a biodegradable bag. (Only use the bags we supply in your food waste caddy)
-  Fill it with food waste.
-  When it is full tie the bag tightly and put in the brown food waste bin in your shared recycling area.
